### January Meeting Minutes

#### Fields Memorial School January 30, 2007

Robin called the meeting to order at 7:50pm. The minutes from the annual meeting January 2006 were reviewed. A motion was made to accept the minutes, seconded, and passed.

#### Treasurers' Report:

Beginning Balance: \$11,067.35  
Income: \$6688.50  
Expenses: \$15,282.04  
Ending Balance: \$2,473.81 for October 2007  
There was a Sponsor Class reimbursement for year-end awards so the Ending Balance is \$2,798.81.  
A motion was made to accept the Treasurer's Report, seconded, and passed.

Robin introduced the 2007 Officers and the Board of Directors.

#### New Business

Robin shared the 2007 show dates locations and judges. Pac approval went out waiting to hear back.

#### **Contracts:**

Robin shared we don't have the contract for Brooklyn as yet. Falls Creek the only increase for this year is that it will be \$15.00 for showing off the trailer.  
There was a discussion held regarding show grounds. Woodstock the only change is they are charging for the toilets but for us it will be a saving we don't need to order the Port~ A~ Pots. We continue to

be charged the clean stall fee, therefore for non-members there will still be a deposit of \$25.00 that will be refunded when the stall is checked and is clean. Everyone must have their stall checked before they leave the show grounds. Any member leaving a dirty stall will be charge \$25.00 per stall and their membership will be "not in good standing" until the fee is paid.  
New this year there will be a \$10.00 per stall late fee for reservations received after the 7 days prior to the show date.

#### **Forms:**

Robin shared that we will only have one main Entry form and only one Stall form, we will still be using the green Youth / Adult Classic Pleasure entry form. You can get the Stall and main Entry forms off the website or Debbie will have all the forms at the meeting.

**Class List:** Robin wanted to remind everyone that the class list flipped from last year. There was a miss print on the class list so watch for the corrected list on the website and Debbie will have the corrected one at the next meeting. Also new to the schedule will be SNEHA Therapeutic Horsemanship. This class will be offered only at the Falls Creek shows. For year-end participation only the 2 meeting requirement will need to be met. Watch for more information.



At the January Board meeting it was decided that we as a Club would become a member of the Connecticut Horse Council. Robin shared two e-mails the first regarding Trails. The DEP has announced that they are making a regulation change specific to horses, which reads as follows: "Trails are open unless posted closed to hiking, mountain biking, or other types of trail-related activities. Horseback riding is prohibited on trails unless posted as permitted. Use of any trail, road or path posted as closed by the DEP is prohibited".
