May 16 show was discussed. Natalie McGowen was in the ring and Charlie Muscarella was the trail judge. There were some issues with the dog show being held at the same time. A few issues were dealt with, but the show

went fairly well. It was the first show we offered driving. The mini division saw an increase in entries. We had 92 entries and we made a profit of \$1802.68.

We still have 1 Board position left to fill. Bob Ahern will be taking the other position. He will start attending next meeting.

Show help is still needed. Help is needed in the secretary's booth. We also need help setting up and tearing down the trail. We also need a volunteer to store and transport the trail obstacles.

New Business

Reminders

Stalls are available for \$30 each. Campers with hookups are \$25, without hookups \$15. Arrival time is after 5 on Saturday. You must provide own bedding. Stalls must be cleaned and checked before leaving the show grounds. Woodstock imposes a \$30 cleaning fee for any stall left dirty. You will not be considered a member in good standing until the fee has been paid.

We have a checkout procedure we go through with Woodstock Manager at end of each show. We can't leave the

grounds until all of our members have left so please plan accordingly.

Minis must be measured by a designated SNEHA official prior to entering the show ring for the first time. You will be given a card and a record will be kept on file, good for the year. Please have your mini measured before entering the ring. Measuring will take place on the cement area near Robin's camper.

Rule books are available on the website or you can purchase one for \$5 to help defray the printing costs.

If you have any SNEHA ribbons or trophies you would like to donate back, we will gladly accept them if they are clean and not written on.
